The affluent society is one in which the basic needs of the majority of citizens are met, allowing most people to focus their productive energies on something other than bare subsistence. Later in the book, Galbraith notes that he feels the writings of many classical economists (such as Ricardo and Smith) should be reappraised due to differences in the economic conditions they experienced.
